JOB SELECTION FOR Maritime and port administrations capacity building expert

The Project "Improvement of Port Customs and Operations Efficiency in Africa Contract no. FED/2019/406-424" is an European Union funded project.

The Overall objective of project IPCOEA is:

 To improve efficiency of customs and administrative clearance process of port operations in accordance to EPAs in Ports of the ECOWAS Area through the implementation of Single Window Systems

To be achieved through the following specific objectives:

- To support the development of a conducive environment for the implementation of a single window approach in ECOWAS areas ports.
- To support the implementation of Port Community Systems in ports of the ECOWAS
- To improve capacity of trade support organizations to support implementation of single window systems
- To acquire and disseminate experience in implementation of single window approach to provide inputs to ECOWAS governments in regard to operational procedures to implement customs reform in accordance to EU-ECOWAS EPA and ECOWAS Customs Union/CET

In order to achieve these objectives, the project will support trade organizations and academic institutions in implementing training and capacity building for the realization of the "single window" approach in African ports' and the implementation of a Port Community System as a driver of a more efficient trade for ECOWAS Countries. The core trade support organization and academic institution are, for the purpose of this project, the two co-applicants:

- PMAWCA: Port Management Association of West and Central Africa, based in Lagos
- ARSTM: Academie Regional des Sciences et Techniques de la Mer, based in Abidjan

The outputs of the project can be summed up as follows:

- A network of professionals, will be set up. These professionals will receive formal medium term training, to design and manage technical assistance for implementing single window approach and establishing Port Community Systems. The members of the network will include the 15 professionals trained under the medium-term training provided by the project and at least 10 other people working in the sector in ECOWAS countries.
- A network of institutions and trade-support organizations aimed at supporting implementation of single window and port community systems
- At least 100 personnel from ports of the ECOWAS region, capable of implementing single window approach through formal training
- At least 7 pilot actions implemented for single window systems and/or Port Community System
- One toolkit providing guidance to decision makers on establishment of Single Window and Port Community System
- One on-line knowledge sharing platform established.

COMPARATIVE EVALUATION OF CANDIDATES AND JUDGING COMMISSION

- 1) The Commission will proceed to the selection through a first selective evaluation of the curricula and the qualifications, taking into account the following elements:
- a) Educational qualifications and professional qualifications
- b) experiences already done in the sector of the activity

Each member of the Commission will make his own evaluation by giving a vote from 0 to 30.

A raking list we will result from the arithmetic average of the marks obtained from all the members of the commission: only candidates who have obtained an average score of no less than 21/30 will be admitted to the second phase of the comparative procedure.

2) Interview for the verification of the requirements

The Commission will publish on the website the list of those admitted to the second phase as well as the schedule of the job interviews.

Each member of the Commission will make his own evaluation assigning to each candidate a vote from 0 to 30.

The selection will be awarded on the basis of the highest grade.

The score assignment carried out in the first phase is intended solely for the purposes of admission to the interview, without any influence on the final evaluation.

In the case that the candidate renounces the job, the same will be proposed to the second in the ranking and so on. The Evaluation Committee reserves the right not to assign the assignment if none of the candidates presented is deemed fit for the tasks.

The evaluation procedure will end with the consequent stipulation of the work contract, subject to prior approval by the Executive Academy Committee

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The selected name will be published on the ACADEMY website no later than 7 days from the date of assignment.
