# <u>PRIVACY POLICY - ASPIRING EMPLOYEES</u> INFORMATION PURSUANT TO ART. 13 OF EU REGULATION 2016/679 (GDPR)

For the recruitment of employees, the Candidate (hereinafter also only the Interested Party) acknowledges that his personal data will be processed by the Fondazione Istituto Tecnico superiore per la mobilità sostenibile – Settore trasporti/marittimi e pesca – ACCADEMIA ITALIANA DELLA MARINA MERCANTILE, with headquarters in Genoa, Via Oderico 10, Tax Code 01597860996 as data Controller (hereinafter also only the Data Controller).

### 1) CATEGORIES OF PERSONAL DATA PROCESSED

The following categories will be processed during the selection phase

After these deadlines, the data will be destroyed and/or anonymised in accordance with the above-mentioned timeframe and, if applicable, used exclusively for statistical and analysis purposes.

# 1) CATEGORIES OF PERSONS TO WHOM THE DATA MAY BE DISCLOSED

The data will be processed exclusively by employees or collaborators of the Controller who are duly appointed, trained, instructed and bound to the processing exclusively for the purposes for which the data were collected. Furthermore, the data may be communicated by the Controller to the following categories of subjects:

- to persons entitled to access the data by virtue of a provision of law, regulation or EU legislation, or on the basis of an order of the Legal Authority, within the limits provided for by such rules or orders;
- to service companies to which it entrusts, also in outsourcing, the technological management of the data, or that offer IT assistance, management and consultancy services as well as the design and creation of software and/or websites, as well as companies or consultants entrusted with providing specific services to the Data Controller (such as, for example, law firms and tax consultants), always within the limits of the purposes for which the data were collected;

Personal data will not be disseminated.

The data may be transferred abroad, in the manner provided for in Article 49 of the GDPR.

#### 1) CONTRACTOR'S RIGHTS

The privacy legislation (Art. 15-23 EU Reg. 2016/679) guarantees the Worker the right to:

- obtain information on the origin of the data, the purposes and methods of processing, the logic applied in the case of processing carried out with the aid of electronic instruments; the details of the persons in charge of processing, the subjects or categories of subjects to whom the data may be communicated or who may become aware of it;
- obtain access, update, rectification or integration of data, the cancellation, transformation into anonymous form or blocking of data processed in breach of the law, including data whose storage is not necessary in relation to the purposes for which the data were collected or subsequently processed, certification that the operations requested have been brought to the attention, also as regards their content, of those to whom the data were communicated, except where this proves impossible or involves a manifestly disproportionate use of means in relation to the protected right;
- object on legitimate grounds to the processing of data concerning him/her, even if pertinent to the purpose of collection, or to the processing of personal data concerning him/her for the purpose of sending commercial and promotional communications, including in part with regard to the possible use of automated contact methods or profiling;

Acknowledgement may take up to 30 days from the date the request was sent.

Without prejudice to any other administrative or judicial remedy, the interested party has the right to lodge a complaint with the Supervisory Authority in cases of alleged violation by the Company of the provisions of EU Regulation 2016/679.
