As a result of the found necessity from the company partner of the undersigned Academy MSC Cruises of the formation and insertion in own crews of specialized technicians that can cover the role of Facility Director, the Parts have inaugurated the collaboration with the departments DIFI-DCCI-DICCA of the University of the Studies of Genoa for the start of a private course of High Formation dedicated to who had the intention to acquire the professional competences of "Facility Director on board Cruise Ships". Please note that the start of the course is subject to reaching the minimum number of 15 registration applications.

Objectives of the course

The course aims to achieve the skills and abilities and the acquisition of knowledge essential to carrying out the profession of Facility Director on board cruise ships.

Professional figure

The Facility Director on board cruise ships ensures the safe and efficient operation of technical and non-technical equipment within the guest and crew areas, leading the maintenance team in planning and delivering every maintenance activity on board, with the objective to minimize any possible discomfort for Cruises guests and crew members.

MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES and TASKS:

- Maintaining contact with the ship's management regarding maintenance procedures
- Guide the maintenance team in planning and delivering every maintenance task on board
- Minimize any possible discomfort for guests and crew members of the cruise ship
- Reporting, scheduling, supervising and inspecting ship maintenance activities in cruise and dock
- Check and check the inventory of spare materials and tools
 Plan all work orders regarding electrical, plumbing, upholstery, carpentry and ship renovation
- Ensure the efficient operation of the ship by ensuring that expenses remain within the budget/budget limits allowed by the company, thus optimizing business costs

The company MSC will offer all the trainees free of charge the compulsory courses STCW BST and Training Ships Pax.

At the end of the formative path, the attendants that will have concluded with success the course of high specialization will be hired directly from the company partner MSC Cruises.

The facility director will embark on the cruise ships of the company MSC for periods of 4/6 months.

The average gross annual income for a Facility Director on board cruise ship is approximately €56,000 gross per year (8 monthly payments) to which all allowances and overtimes must be added.

For the entry level Facility Director Junior (internship) the average gross annual income is approximately €36,000 gross per year (8 monthly payments) to which all allowances and overtimes must be added.

Planned editions of the course

The course is only one edition, aimed at a minimum of 15/maximum 25 students.

Please note that the start of the course is subject to the achievement of a minimum number of 15 registered students.

Taget

The course is aimed at a minimum of 15/maximum 25 students in possession of a Nautical upper secondary education diploma and professional title CoC Deck or Engine Officer OR in possession of an ITS Diploma level EQF5 Ship Manager/Superintendent, Supervisor and installator of onboard plants, Logistics Technician OR ITS Diploma level EQF6 Deck or Engine Officer OR Bachelor in one of the specialization listed in the below paragraph.

Candidates who place themselves in the first 25 places in the ranking will be admitted to the course.

The list of those admitted will be published in due time on the Academy website. In the event of withdrawal of one or more students or failure of those admitted to meet the requirements, the final ranking will be drawn and scrolled until the maximum number of 25 students is reached.

Admission requirements

Those who intend to participate in the selection for admission to the course, on the expiry date of this Notice, must possess the following minimum mandatory requirements:

- a) Maximum age 40 years, on the date of submission of the application;
- b) Citizenship of the European Union or of non-EU countries with possession of a regular residence permit and/or visa;
- c) Good knowledge of the English language (minimum level B2);
- d) For EU citizens: valid identity document;
- e) For non-EU citizens: Valid passport.

Those who do not do so within the established deadlines will **NOT** be able to continue attending the course and **will** be automatically EXCLUDED FROM THE RANKING LIST, even if they were admitted following the selection process.

Access to the courses takes place in compliance with the principles established by Legislative Decree, 11 April 2006, n. 198.

For candidates who have obtained the required qualification abroad, a certificate of value is required (issued by the Italian Embassy/Consulate of the country of origin) in accordance with current legislation (Law 11 July 2002, n. 148 and subsequent additions).

Registration method

To access the selection, interested parties in possession of the listed requirements must send the "Registration Application" duly completed and signed with the following documentation attached:

- For EU citizens: Unauthenticated full copy (front and back) of the identity card or other valid identification document;

Selection Commission Access to the course is subject to evaluation through procedures for verifying technical, attitudinal and motivational skills established and managed by a Commission made up of sector and training experts. The selection commission is made up of 3 members including: A representative of the Academy Training Body A representative of the MSC Cruises An English language teacher/expert An occupational psychologist Verification method

The verification methods are as follows:

Interview that will take place online (remotely) with which it is possible to accrue up to 50 points, consisting of:

- o Knowledge of English
- o Knowledge of the technical aspects relating to the profession the candidate will be carrying out
- O Psycho-attitudinal profile drawn up by the psychologist during the interview

I Candidates with specific learning disabilities (DSA) must present the relevant documentation, issued by the NHS structures or by bodies or professionals accredited by the Regions, by the closing date of this notice.

The selection tests are organized in accordance with the provisions of the current legislation (Liguria Region, Executive Decree no. 5117 of 7 November 2016 and subsequent amendments).

Aspects that can contribute to the final evaluation are:

the diploma grade up to a maximum of 5 points;

- previous experience in similar work up to a maximum of 45 points.

In the event of an equal score between two or more applicants for the course, the younger one will take precedence.

Candidates who place themselves in the first 25 places in the ranking will be admitted to the course.

Test calendar

The online interview will be held on the Google Edufaimm platform accredited by the Academy from the 11th to the 13th MARCH 2024, according to methods that will be communicated upon publication of the list of those admitted to the test.

The selection tests are organized in accordance with the provisions of current legislation (Liguria Region, Executive Decree no. 5117 of 7 November 2016 and subsequent amendments).

It is advisable to periodically check the website of the Italian Shipping Academy to verify any communications and information.

You will only be able to take the selection interview if you have a valid identification document.

Failure to attend the selection tests on the date and time of the call will be considered a waiver of participation in the course. If this situation occurs, the participation fee paid will not be refunded.

Each candidate is required to test his/her connection for the online test in advance. The failure to connect is not attributable to the Italian Academy of the Merchant Navy.

At the end of the selection, a final ranking will be drawn up on the basis of which the candidates who place in the first 25 places will be admitted to the course.

In case of equal scores, the younger candidate will be admitted to the course.

Structure and organization of the course

The course will last approximately 1042 hours, structured as follows:

- 702 hours divided in ground-based teaching modules that will take place at the seats of the Academy in Genoa and Arenzano (GE), at specialized training centers and on board MSC cruise ships;
- almost 90 hours at specialized training centers authorized by MIT for the compulsory training STCW BST and Crowd & Crisis;
- 250hours of internship on board MSC Cruise ships.

The shipping company MSC will offer to all attendants free of charge STCW BST and Crowd & Crisis courses.

Lesson times: from Monday to Friday, from 8.30 am to 12.30 pm and from 1.30 pm to 5.30 pm, for a total of 8 hours per day, unless otherwise structured for educational needs.

Students who have successfully attended at least 90% of the lesson hours will successfully pass the course, thus obtaining the final certification of Facility Director on board cruise ships released by the Academy.

The lessons will be held for the majority in English.

ATTENDANCE IS SUBJECT TO PASSING THE SELECTION TESTS

ATTENDANCE IS MANDATORY.

Course plan

Lessons will generally take place from Monday to Friday for a maximum of 8 hours per day. Attendance at the course is mandatory. Absences are permitted up to a maximum of 10% of the total course hours (104 hours of absence allowed). During the course, changes may be introduced to the duration and times of lessons based on teaching and organizational needs.

Start of the course

The course will start on Monday 18th March 2024, unless otherwise communicated.

The lessons will end by July 2024.

Main teaching units

The courses are divided into teaching units, each of which contributes to ensuring that the student achieves the skills required by current legislation on the subject.

Below are the main macro areas that will be the subject of study:

Competence 1 – Materials Science and Technology

Competence 2 – Soft Skills (leadership, team-working, problem solving, effective communication)

Competence 3 – Typological, constructive and functional characteristics of the ship - Main naval regulations

Competence 4 - Project Management

Competence 5 - IMO RULES AND REGULATION

Competence 6 - CARPENTRY - DRY WORK - PAINTING

Competence 7 - INTRODUCTION on machinery and systems of motor apparatus - Electrical and electronic systems - Automation systems

Competence 8 - Systems and installations for miscellaneous services, Ship security systems

ONBOARD INTERNSHIP: 250 hours

The students will have to take specific verification tests aimed at ascertaining the acquisition of the knowledge and skills required by the various macro areas and the achievement of the skills required by current legislation.

Costs and payment methods

The cost per person is € 6.100 (+VAT 22%) excluding accommodation and food costs.

The payment of €4,000 is to be made no later than 04/03/2024. The remaining fee must be paid no later than the starting date of the course.

If the minimum number of 6 registrations is not reached and the course does not take place, the participation fee will be refunded.

If the candidate does not pass the interview, the participation fee will be refunded.

- in the event of failure to complete the documentary part within the deadline set (course start date 18/03/2024) the participation fee paid will not be refunded.

High Professional training Course for FACILITY DIRECTOR on board Cruise Ships

Rules for the attendants
